HOW TO LIGHT THE HANUKKIYAH




CANDLE PLACEMENT AND LIGHTING

Candles are placed from right to left.

Just like Hebrew

Candles are lit from left to right. Honoring the new day first.



BLESSINGS

Light the Shamash // (the helper candle that lights the other candles) then recite:

1 Barukh attah adonai, eloheinu, melekh ha-olam, asher kidd'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivvanu l'hadlik neir shel hanukkah.

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה׳ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֱלֶךְ הָעוֹלְם אֲשֶׁר קִדְשְׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתִיו וְצִוְּנוּ לְהַדְלִיק נֵר שֵׁל חֲנָכַּה.

Praised are You, Adonai, our God, Sovereign of the universe, who, sanctifying us with divine commandments, has commanded us to kindle the Hanukkah lamp.

2 Barukh attah adonai, eloheinu, melekh ha-olam, she-asah nissim la-avoteinu ba-yamim ha-heim u-va-z'man ha-zeh. בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלֶם שׁעֲשָׂה נִסִים לַאֲבוֹתֵינוּ בַּיָמִים הַהֵם וּבַזְמַן הַזֵה.

Praised are You, Adonai, our God Sovereign of the universe, who wrought miracles for our ancestors at this time in ancient days.

On the first night only, recite:

3 Barukh attah adonai, eloheinu, melekh ha-olam, she-heheyyanu, vekiyamanu, vehigiyanu lezman hazeh. בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה׳ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלְם שֶׁהֶחֶיָנוּ וְקִיְמְנוּ וָהִגִּיעֵנוּ לַזִמֵן הַזָּה.

Praised are You, Adonai, our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has given us life, sustained us, and brought us to this occasion.

HANUKKAH SONGS

HA-NEIROT HALLALU

Following lighting the candles, it is customary to sing the paragraph Ha-neirot Hallalu, which makes explicit the purpose of our lighting the menorah and the prohibition of making practical use of the light it casts:

Ha-neirot ha-lalu anu madlikim al ha-nisim v'al ha-nifla'ot v'al ha-t'shu'ot v'al ha-milhamot. She-asita la-avoteinu ba-yamim ha-heim ba-z'man ha-zeh. These lights which we kindle recall the wondrous triumphs and the miraculous victories wrought through Your holy Kohanim for our ancestors from ancient days until our time. These lights are sacredthrough all the eight days of Hanukkah. We may not make use of their light, but are only to look upon them, and thus be reminded to thank and praise You for the wondrous miracle of our deliverance.

MAOZ TZUR

This is followed by the singing of Ma·oz Tzur (Rock of Ages), the most famous of all Hanukkah songs. Below you will find the first verse.

Ma'oz tzur y'shu'ati, L'kha na'eh l'shabei'ah, Tikon beit t'filati, V'sham todah n'zabei'ah, L'eit takhin matbei'ah, Mi-tzor hamnabei'ah, Az egmor b'shir mizmor, Hanukkat ha-mizbei'ah. מְעוֹז צוּר יְשׁוּעְתִי לְךּ נָאֶה לְשַׁבֵּחַ. תִּכּוֹן בֵּית תְּפִלְתִי וְשָׁם תּוֹדָה נְזַבֵּחַ. לְצֵת תָּכִין מַטְבֵּחַ מִצָּר הַמְנַבֵּחַ. אָז אֵגְמוֹר בִּשִׁיר מִזְמוֹר חַנָבַּת הַמִּזְבֵּחַ.

Rock of Ages, Let our song, Praise Your saving power. You amid the raging throng, Were our sheltering tower. Furious they assailed us, But Your help availed us. And Your word broke their sword When our own strength failed us.
